Another successful Equine Assisted Learning (EAL) course was held here at Ivey Ranch! EAL is a 13-week curriculum based program that combines ground handling of horses, riding, developmental assets (integrity, follow through, punctuality, etc.) writing, and group planning and discussion. Ivey Ranch has partnered with Interfaith Services for the past two years and provided services to both Oceanside and El Camino High School students. Many of these students will be returning this Spring to continue in a 2nd-year curriculum of EAL.

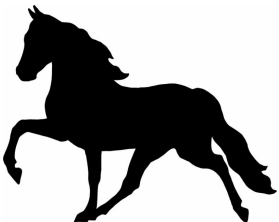
