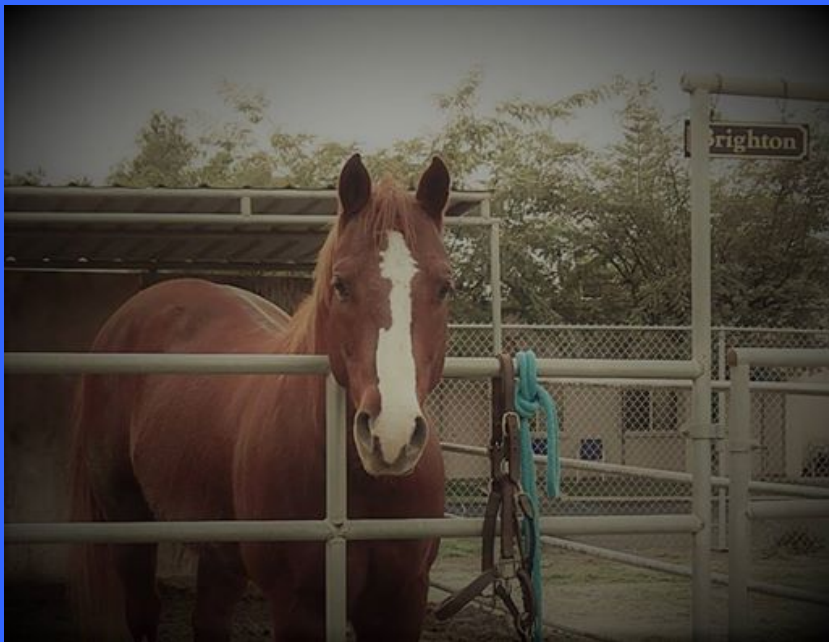

He is kind and gentle, but intelligent and playful, as well. He is an excellent teacher and can take riders from the very beginning stages of learning how to walk and stop and steer, all the way up to cantering and attempting to jump.
