#### Registered Instructor Certification Process

In order to become a PATH Certified Instructor, you must successfully complete the two phases of the certification process. For additional information on this process, please refer to the PATH website at [www.pathintl.org](http://www.pathintl.org) under *Instructor Certification* drop down menu. Any questions that you have regarding Phase One should be directed to the PATH office, and questions regarding Phase Two should be directed to Ivey Ranch.

#### Phase One (PATH)

With the submission of your Registered Instructor Certification Application Form, an application fee, copies of current CPR and First Aid Certification and PATH membership number or application to the PATH office, you will officially enter Phase One. Components of **Phase One** include:

- \*PATH Intl. Standards Course (Formerly CAT Course)
- \* PATH Intl. Standards Exam (Formerly CAT Exam)
- \*Instructor Self-Study
- \*PATH Registered Instructor Open Book Exam
- \*Complete the Horsemanship Skills Checklist

Note: You will have six months to complete the Phase One Packet. Please note the Standards course/exam has a 60-day time frame and the Instructor self-study/Open book exam has a 6-month time frame.

Upon successful completion of Phase one, you will receive a confirmation of Instructor in Training status letter from the PATH office. At this point, you are considered a **PATH Instructor-In-Training**. You may retain this designation for twelve months from the date of your letter. At that time, you may also sign up for an On-Site Workshop and Certification.

**Phase Two (Host Site- Ivey Ranch Park)**

Within the twelve months after completing phase one, you must complete all the components of Phase 2. They are:

- \*25 hours of practice teaching mounted therapeutic riding group lessons under the direct supervision of a PATH Certified Instructor
- \*Attend a Registered Instructor On-Site Workshop. You must attend the workshop PRIOR to the certification
- \*Successfully complete a Registered Instructor On-Site Certification

If you are interested in attending, please complete the attached form and mail with appropriate fees to the address listed. You will also need to include a copy of your Instructor-In-Training letter. Candidates are registered on a first come-first serve basis, so register early. **All certification candidates must register 32 days prior to OSWC.**

After receiving full registration, Ivey Ranch Park will send you **Phase 2 packet**. It will include:

- \* on-site registration form
  - \* A form for Instructor Resume, Personal Reference, Professional Reference and Essay Questions
  - \*Emergency Medical Treatment, Liability and Confidentiality forms
  - \*Documentation of Teaching Hours Form
- You will need to complete the Phase 2 paper work and return it to Ivey Ranch with a copy of your PATH membership card and CPR/First Aid Cards. All forms must be returned to Ivey Ranch 2 weeks prior to the beginning of the OSWC

From I-5:  
Take the 76 East Expressway  
Go East on the 76 Expressway to Rancho del Oro Drive (approx. 4 miles)  
Turn North (left) onto Rancho del Oro Drive and turn right into the first, and only, driveway on the right hand side.

From I-15:  
Take the 76 West Expressway  
Go West on the 76 Expressway to Rancho del Oro Drive (approx. 13 miles)  
Turn North (right) onto Rancho del Oro Drive and turn right into the first, and only, driveway on the right hand side.
