Ways to utilize Out-of-Home Respite (OHR):

- **Adult Day Program:** After-hours care for individuals 18+/22+ with special needs. Includes functional skills, vocational development, recreation, and community outings.
- **School-Age Program:** Care is available for individuals ages 4–22 who are enrolled in Transitional Kindergarten (TK) through age 22 educational programs. Services are provided before and after school and during school breaks.
- **Skills Training:** Group-based activities for teens/young adults in horse care, barn chores, gardening, maintenance, and hospitality.
- **Instructor In Training:** Education for those interested in equine instruction and management.
