



WORKING INTERN PROGRAM

This program operates Mon- Fri, 9am to 6pm, with schedules customized to each participant's needs. Regional Center clients may use Out of Home Respite hours for this program.

The Working Intern Program (WIP) is designed for teens and young adults with disabilities or special needs. It offers supported group experiences that promote both personal and practical skill development.

WIP also focuses on community inclusion, independent living, recreation, and self-advocacy. As participants progress, they may become eligible for Tailored Day Services or a Paid Internship Program.

To enroll, individuals must be 15 years of age or older, able to follow directions, behave appropriately in social settings, and work safely in small groups.
